



4th Sunday of Lent 27

Read together
John 9:1-7.

Light a candle at dinner. Pray together, "Jesus is the light of the world."

Close your eyes for a moment. What do you hear? Now try to listen deeper. What might God be saying to you?

Ask your family: 29

When do we try to come closer to God? What can get in our way?

Invite a friend or family member to make Easter butterflies with you.

Use coffee filters, pipe cleaners and watercolor paints to create colorful butterflies.

Bake some treats for your family. Then take some to a neighbor, too.

Gather your family and an armful of stuffed animals. Together act out Bible stories. How about the story of the runaway son? (Luke 15)

5th Sunday of Lent 3

Read together
John 11:21-27.

What does Martha believe?

Is there a kind note you can write about each of your family members? Hide the notes in places you know they will find them!

Spring is a time of new life. Plant a few seeds in a clay pot and place it in a sunny spot. Water a bit each day and watch for new life to grow.

Invite family members to help find and collect small rocks. Then, fill a shallow bowl with water and take turns placing the rocks into the water as you pray (silently or aloud) for God's strength and protection.

Read a verse or two from the Bible and then draw a picture about what you read. Try Psalm 23!
