

Easter Sunday – April 20 – 8:00am and 10:30am Renewal of Baptismal Promises, Blessing with the Easter Water,


Celebration of the Holy Eucharist



Reminder that it is the time of season to tidy up and remove winter items on the headstones of your loved ones. Please do so before


Wednesday, March 26th


